- Once a K9 retires after 8 to 10 years of service, the city no longer provides any financial support to the handler.
- Once they retire, they are adopted by their handler and all expenses then fall on the handler.

Expenses:

- Medical Bills
- Food
- All other cost associated with the care of the K9 for its lifetime.
- Death Cost



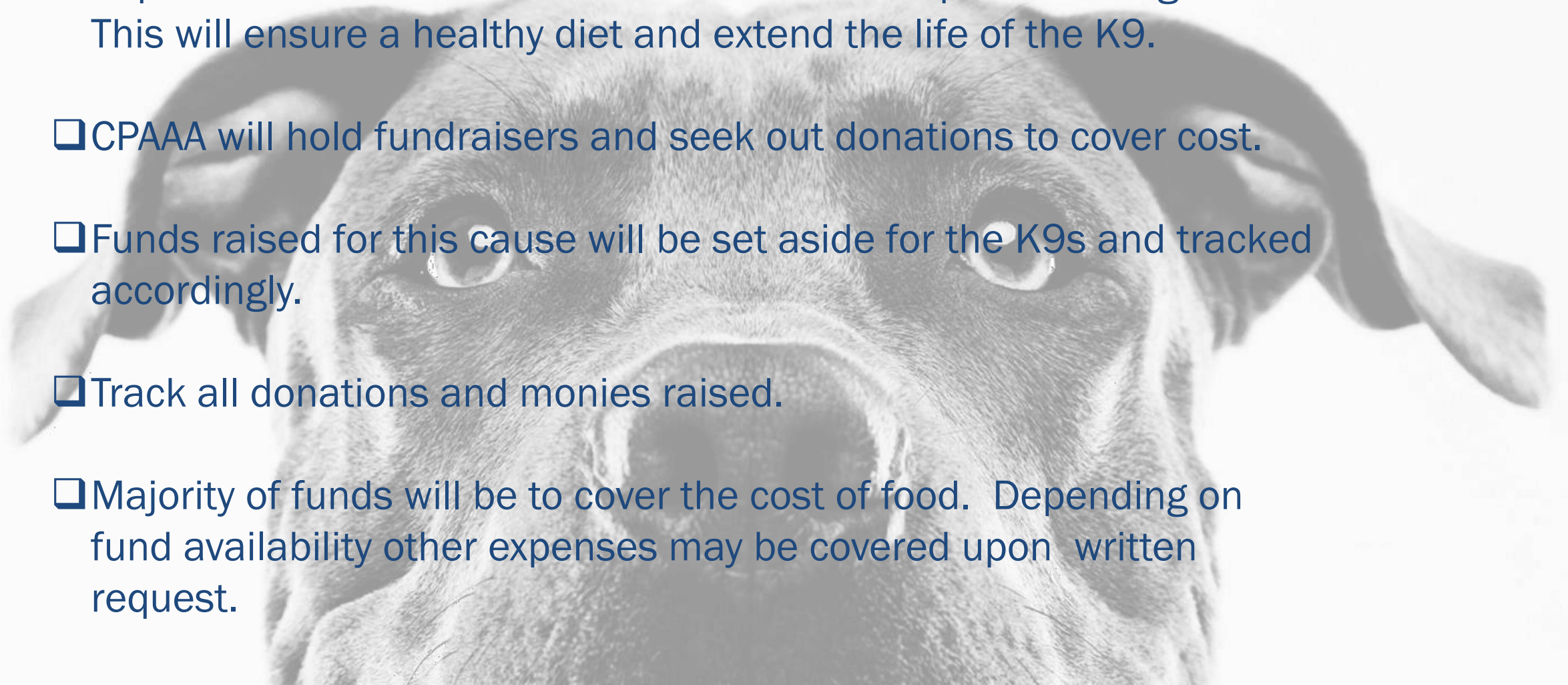
Number of K9's in Program

What CPAAA is doing:

- Set up an account with Healthy Pet to allow the retired K9 handler to purchase the same brand of food for the K9 prior to being retired. This will ensure a healthy diet and extend the life of the K9.
- CPAAA will hold fundraisers and seek out donations to cover cost.
- Funds raised for this cause will be set aside for the K9s and tracked accordingly.
- Track all donations and monies raised.
- Majority of funds will be to cover the cost of food. Depending on fund availability other expenses may be covered upon written request.
